- 2. The topic of the essay is "What the American Flag Means to Me". Please encourage the children to express their feelings on the Flag and how it relates to marching in the Flag Day Parade.
- 3. Essays should not be longer than one page.
- 4. Essays should include student's name, age, school, class, and teachers name at the top of the page.

#### **Teachers:**

- 1. Awards will be presented to two students:
  - a. The two student winners will each receive a \$100 check and engraved plaque
  - b. Each of their schools will receive a \$150 check and engraved plaque
- 2. Please choose the three best essays in each class and send only those to be considered in the contest.
- 3. The deadline for submitting your three finalist essays for each class is May 24<sup>nd</sup>.
- 4. The two winners will be selected by the SRNY Flag Day Committee and notified by **June 1st**. Winners will be asked to read their essays at the Flag Day ceremony following the parade on June 14<sup>th</sup> in front of Fraunces Tavern<sup>®</sup>.
